The event offered an extensive and dynamic program, featuring cutting-edge discussions led by leading experts in the field of colorectal surgery. The strong attendance and engagement reaffirm the commitment of our professional community to continuous learning and academic excellence.

This year, TJCD had the opportunity to expand its academic and educational mission at the congress. The interactive analysis of sample manuscripts enriched the educational content and enhanced its practical value.

I would like to extend my appreciation to our Editorial Board Members who contributed to the course and to our distinguished international speakers, Dr. Peter Christensen and Dr. Alaa El-Hussuna, for elevating the scientific content and global scope of the event.
